1. On the 19 December of 2019 this court committed the following named person to prison

2. In relation to an order dated

25 November 2019

3. which provided that the Respondent/ Defendant should not

- i) Enter the London Borough of Tower Hamlets
- ii) rough sleep in the communal areas of any residential property (includes but not limited to bin chutes and stairwells) or schools in the London Borough of Tower Hamlets
- iii) use or be in possession of any illegal drugs or substances such as but not limited to heroin, crack cocaine and cannabis or drug paraphernalia such as a crack pipe, foil or cling film wraps within the London Borough of Tower Hamlets.
- iv) Engage in conduct causing or capable of causing nuisance and annoyance to any person in the London Borough of Tower Hamlets

4. the court found that following admissions made he had disobeyed/breached that order by

- i) 1. On 18 Dec 2019 rough sleeping at Blythendale House, Mansford Street, E1 in breach of paragraphs 1, 3 and 5 of the Injunction Order
- 2. On 18 Dec 2019 being in possession of a crack pipe in breach of paragraphs 5 and 5 of the Injunction Order

5. and imposed the following sentence(s) for those breach(es)

breach	Sentence
1. On 18 Dec 2019 rough sleeping at Blythendale House, Mansford Street, E1 in breach of paragraphs 1, 3 and 5 of the Injunction Order	i)18 weeks for each offence to run concurrently with the Order of District Judge Stone of 10 December 2019
2. On 18 Dec 2019 being in possession of a crack pipe in breach of paragraphs 5 and 5 of the Injunction Order

6. Accordingly it was ordered that⁽²⁾ Martin Gegeris

be committed for contempt to Her Majesty's Prison at⁽³⁾ Pentonville or other such prison a (total) period of 18 weeks or until lawfully discharged if sooner
